Statement of the Spokesperson
of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation
of the Kingdom of Cambodia

The Spokesperson of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation deeply regrets to learn of the Facebook post of H.E. Lee Hsien Loong, Prime Minister of Singapore, on 31 May expressing his condolences on the passing of General Prem Tinsulanonda, former Prime Minister of Thailand, in which he wrote: "His [General Prem] time as PM coincided with the ASEAN members (then five of us) coming together to oppose Vietnam's invasion of Cambodia and the Cambodian government that replaced the Khmer Rouge ..."

Prime Minister Lee Hsien Loong's message reflects Singapore's position then in support of the genocidal regime of the Khmer Rouge and Singapore's wish for its return to power in Cambodia. Singapore was the host of the tripartite meeting that led to the formation of the Coalition Government of Democratic Kampuchea, which in effect had engendered the prolonged civil war and suffering for another 10 more years to the Cambodian people who survived the untold atrocity under the Khmer Rouge rule. Prime Minister Lee Hsien Loong's message is tantamount to an insult to the victims of the Khmer Rouge's killing field and the sacrifice of Vietnamese voluntary troops who helped liberate them from this genocidal regime.
